

Classroom Expectations

1. Sit with feet on floor, bottom on the chair, and facing your desk.

Meeting Expectations

1. The class receives compliments when following our Cattitude Expectations. (When the class receives compliments from other teachers, substitutes, etc., I double the compliment.) Having earned 30 compliments, the class receives a reward, for example, a movie, pop, popcorn, extra recess, etc.
2. PBS (Positive Behavior System) also provides Paw Stickers for good Cattitude. Each Friday, individual students earn a sticker for having 2 or less misbehavior marks for the week. PBS hosts a grade-level activity for students having 8 stickers per Quarter.
3. Cassville Intermediate also hosts a Perfect Attendance Party each Quarter for students in attendance at least 96% of the Quarter.

Not Meeting Expectations

- 1st – Students are given a warning
- 2nd – Students will walk 10 minutes at recess
- 3rd – Students will walk 20 minutes at recess
- 4th – Parents are notified via phone/note of continued misbehavior. Students will write an apology letter to parents which will be returned the following day with parent's signature.
- 5th – Student will be sent to the principal.
